

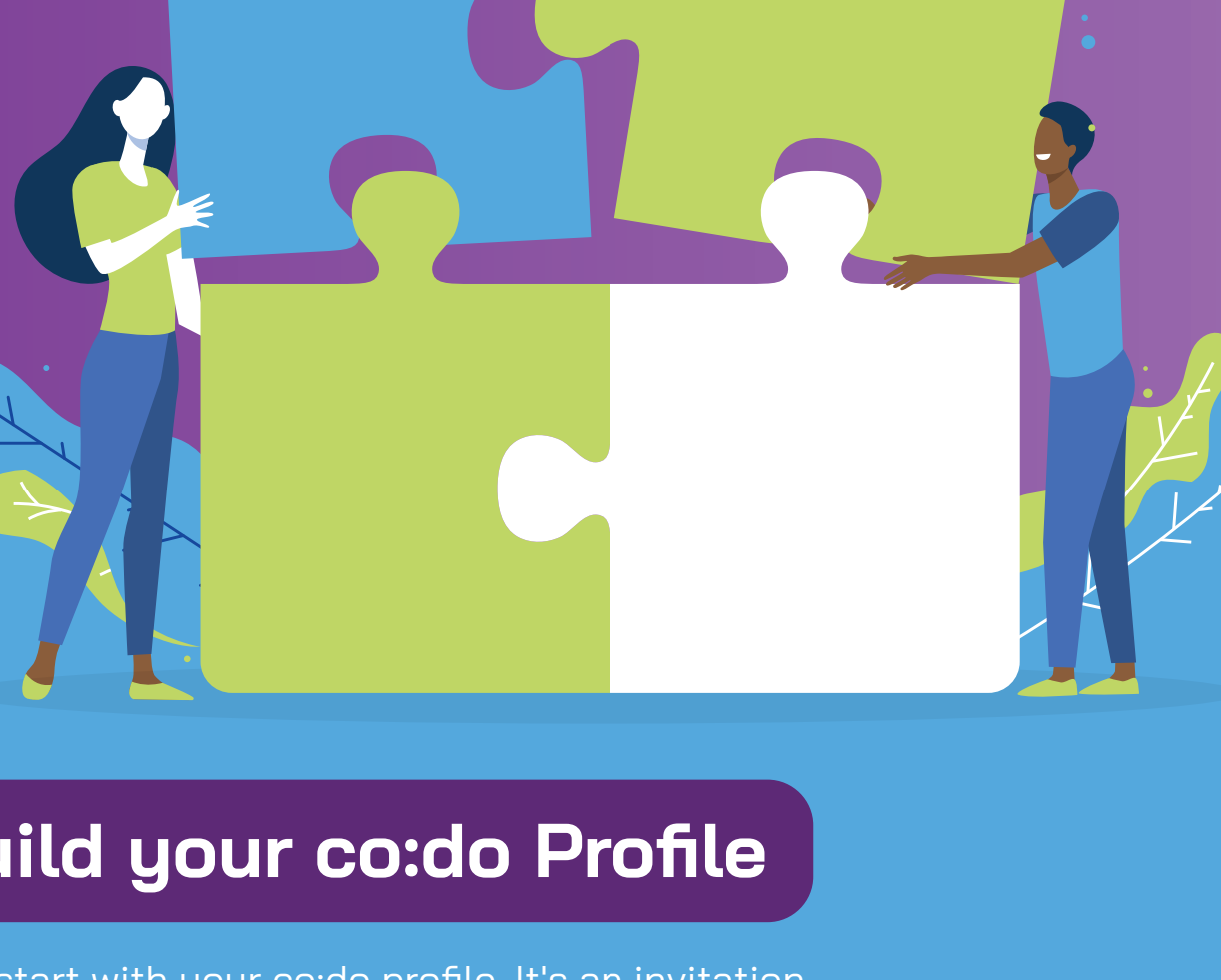


co:do

co:do is a new collaboration platform for changemakers.

This overview explains how individuals can use co:do in practice.



Build your co:do Profile

You start with your co:do profile. It's an invitation to share your background, values and priorities - whatever makes you "you."



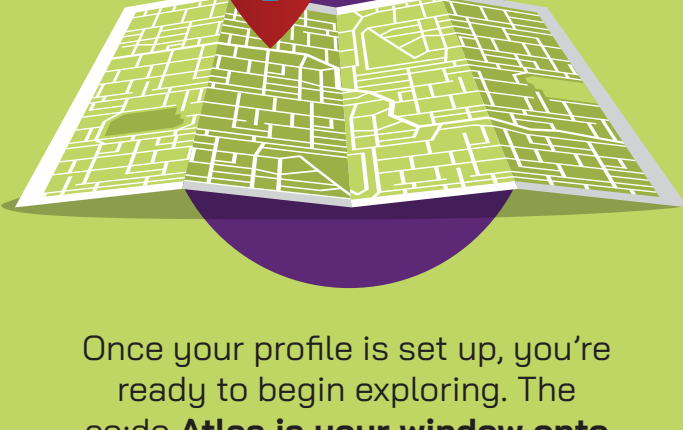
It's also an opportunity to reflect on **what you have to offer** - your time, skills, knowledge, ideas, connections, and anything else you might want to share. And if you're new to these questions, co:do can help you think them through.



Your co:do Profile is your **identity on the platform** and can be updated just as often as your circumstances and ideas evolve, moving with you every step of your changemaker journey.



Explore the co:do Atlas



Once your profile is set up, you're ready to begin exploring. The co:do **Atlas is your window onto the world of changemaking**. Use it to explore places and issues, to meet your fellow users, and to discover what ideas and initiatives are already out there.



The Atlas will offer a user-curated **map of people, projects, needs and offers**. And to help you make sense of all this information, the co:do Compass, a powerful search and filtering tool, will help illuminate what's most relevant. All the information you need to level-up your changemaking, in one convenient place.

Grow your co:do Network

Once you've begun exploring, you're ready to begin building your network, connecting and building relationships with the other users, projects, and communities on the platform.

co:do is designed to enable you to **intuitively visualise this network**, to organise it on your terms, and to **navigate its many connections** as seamlessly as possible. Our cross-channel chat tool allows you to maintain a diversity of group and one-to-one conversations, all in one place.



Meet your co:do Matches



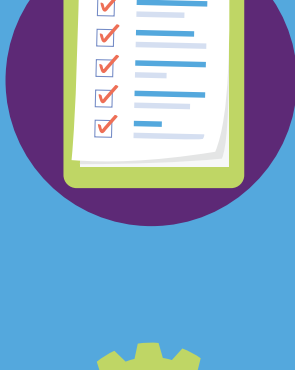

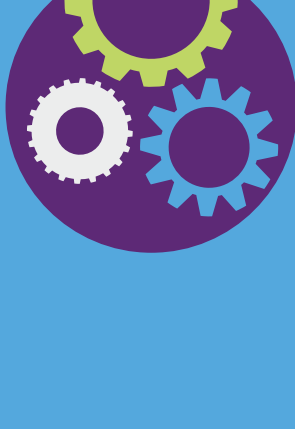

Press the Red Button

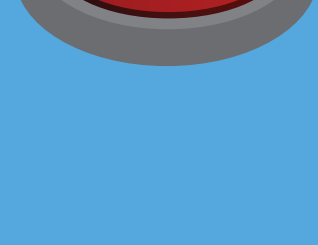
Ready to start your own changemaking project or community? Then **it's time to press the red button**: co:do's innovative wizard for project development.

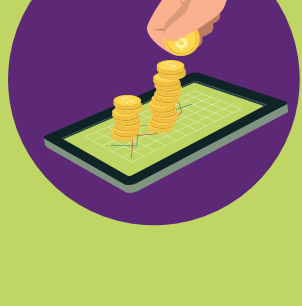
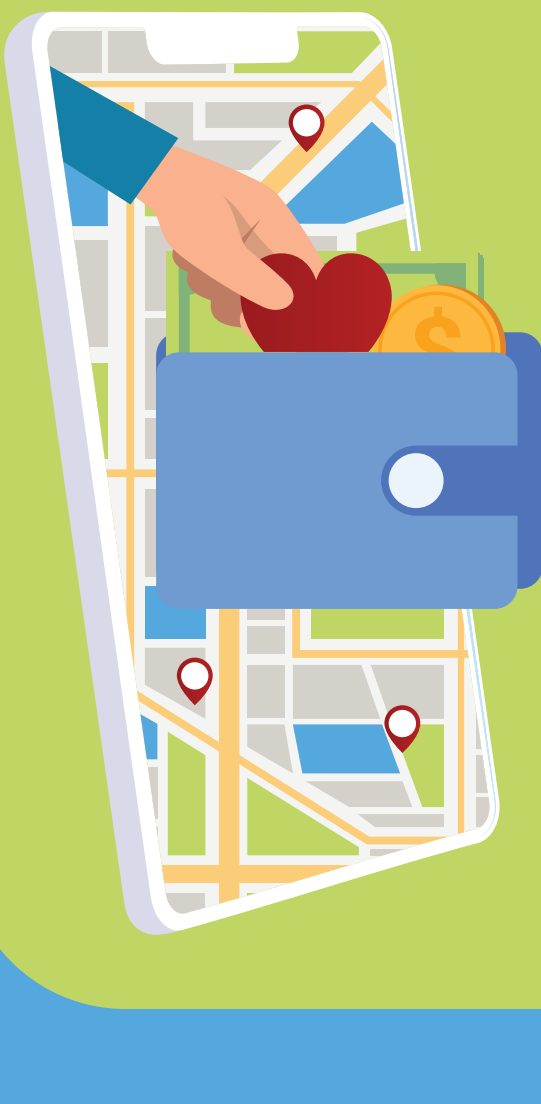

Use your co:do Wallet

Ready to help fund the change you want to see? Whether you have spare change or big bucks, pesos or cryptos, the co:do Wallet helps you to equip your fellow changemakers with the resources they need.



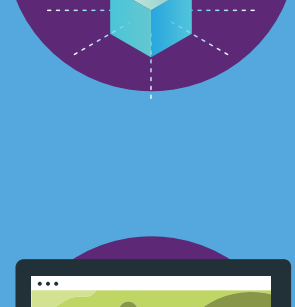
It works like any other digital wallet, except you can **only spend its contents on changemaking**, and not on yourself. Top it up with different kinds of currency from a variety of sources, and then decide how you want to spread it around.



You can do your research, compare different projects and give **directly** to the ones you most support. You can **automate donations** to the most popular projects tackling the specific issues you care about, trusting and delegating to those who have taken the time to choose among them. And you can also **offer up your funds to the common pool**, where the crowd decides with which issues and which projects they will be put to best use. In each case, the co:do wallet brings altruism into the twenty-first century.

Enough with Big Tech!

co:do is built differently from other platforms. It stands for a bold new vision of the internet, rejecting the exploitative and manipulative practices typically used by Big Tech.



We're moving the platform towards a 'decentralised' system, which means there'll be **no central intermediary controlling your data** - you own it and store it on your own terms, with your privacy and security front-and-centre. co:do will always be a not-for-profit venture, so there's **no one selling your data on to the highest bidders either**.



We're also building co:do to be as interoperable as possible, meaning an end to the siloes that make it hard to move your activity from one platform to another. And finally, **our code is all open-source**, so anyone can examine it, propose edits, and create new versions at any time.
